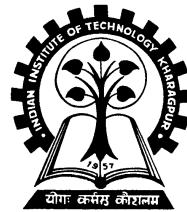

Overview

The course will emphasize on some important skills necessary to develop large software products. The course would address requirements specification, process models, design, testing, and a few current topics, with a special emphasis on the roles of abstraction and decomposition and their use through out the software life cycle. Considering that modern software products are large, emphasis would be given to architectural and detailed design. Both procedural and object-oriented design would be discussed. UML and Unified process, that have gained wide acceptance would be given due importance with exposure to usage of CASE tools. Testing, quality assurance, and software reliability would be discussed with adequate emphasis.
